How to Access Webcast Courses

The following screens will take you through the login process for your GET WIRED! Course.

You will need your username and password to enter the eCampus. Your username and password is the same as your username and password used to access the WECA website. Please note that your password is cAsE-sEnSiTiVe.

Your default username and password is set-up as below:

Default username: 6-digit Student ID *(located on your class confirmation letter)*

Default password*: Last 6 digits of the student's social security number

** Note: You can change your password on the WECA website at any time. If you have changed your password on the WECA website, your password will be correspondingly updated on the eCampus site. Allow 24 hours for the change to take effect. In this event, your old password will still work. If you have forgotten your password, call the WECA office.*
