This is our main website. Here you can:

- Log in and sign up for classes

- eCampus.goweca.com

This is where you log in to attend eCampus classes such as **Get Wired** and other self-paced courses.

Step 1:

Go to <http://www.goweca.com> and log in using your student ID and Password.

- Your username is your six-digit Student ID number.
- Your default password is the last six digits of your social security number.
- You can change your password on the WECA website at any time. If you have changed your password on the WECA website, your password will be correspondingly updated on the eCampus site.
- Use the “Forgot Username” or “Forgot Password” options as needed.

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Step 2:

- Static electricity and magnetism
- Resistors

- Voltage drop and neutral sizing for services

- Switch control of lighting circuits, receptacle installation, bonding, and induction heating

Safety best practices are covered along with tips on study skills. In this course, math equations are applied to the safe and sound wiring and load choices for electrical installations, troubleshooting and maintenance. Theories are discussed and applied to on-the-job situations and tasks.
