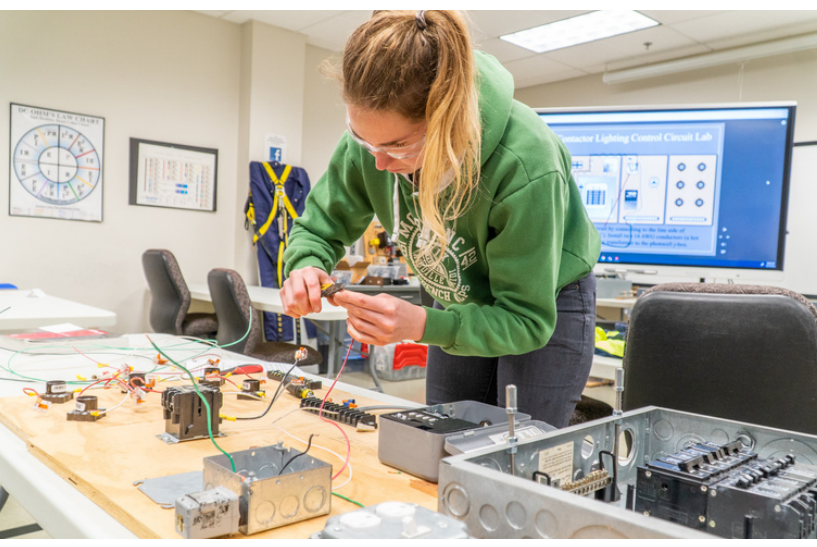
Facts
